Today I would call us to lift the level of expectation as we engage in life. What is it you expect today?

In Mark 6 there are two incidents in the life of Jesus which speak clearly about the level of expectation. Jesus comes to his home town (Mark 6:1-6). He meets up with those who recognise him as the carpenter, the son of Mary and brother to other members of the family. The Bible says these people took offence at him. Because of the level of expectations from these people Jesus ministry was hindered and it says Jesus "was amazed at their lack of faith."

What was at the root of this unbelief? It was the familiarity. Be careful when you become so familiar with your world, that you miss the opportunities for God to move supernaturally in your midst. For me, if my familiar environment is causing a lack of momentum, I must raise the level of expectation I carry. What can cause change to the cry— "we have always done this like this" is the level of expectation you carry. See your world differently.

Look now as contrast to the end of Chapter 6 verses 53-56 says people recognised Jesus. They ran throughout the whole region & carried the sick on mats & wherever he went they placed the sick in the market places, they begged him to let them touch the edge of his cloak & the Bible says "all who touched him were healed".

Can you see the difference? It was in the level of expectation. Arise today from reading this with a greater level of expectation for God to move supernaturally in your world. Embrace your world with the expectation to lay everything out before God, with expectation for Him to touch it and so result in Kingdom power being released.

Break the environment of unbelief, by a greater level of expectation.

Come on Hutt City .. Lets raise our expectation for MORE!!
